
I wish you all a wonderful half term and hope you are able to get out and about. I'll keep my fingers crossed for bright, sunny days.

Cake Sale


Inspired by their learning, some of the members of Snow Leopards are going to do a cake sale after half-term to raise money to help save the rainforests. The details are as follows:

If your child is a close contact you should LFT daily to pick up asymptomatic cases.




Safeguarding and Online Safety
