

Sun Protection

As the summer term progresses, we hope[!] that there will be plenty of sunny days ahead and the children will be able to make good use of the field and outside areas. Please make sure your child has a named sun-hat to wear in the coming months. Sun hats can be purchased from the school office. Closed-in shoes/sandals should be worn; no open-toed sandals, thank you. We recommend you apply sun lotion to your child before school. Further protective sunscreen can be applied during the day by the children. School staff will apply skin cream for children under medical direction.



Parking

We can all agree that parking at our school is limited! Please be reminded that you must not park on the yellow zig zag road markings or the bus stop directly outside the school gates. Parking on a single yellow line between the hours displayed on the road sign [8am-6pm] is also not allowed. Leaving a car on these road markings represents a significant hazard to pedestrians trying to cross the road. It is also causing traffic blockages for other road users travelling up and down St John's Hill.

We would also reiterate the need to respect our neighbours and community in the surrounding roads. Harleston Villas is a private road where parking is for residents only. At no time should vehicles be parked on white markings denoting access to individual properties or across driveways.
