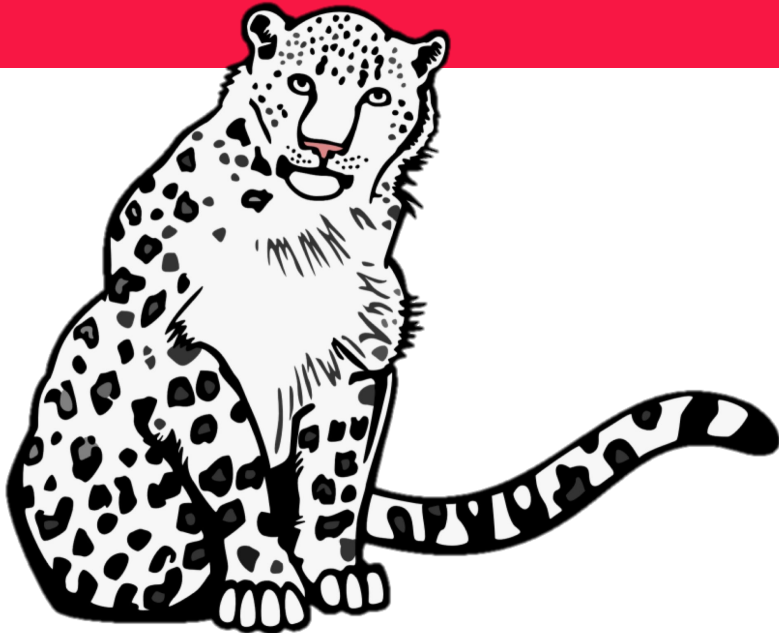

Only stud earrings and an analogue watch are permitted (cultural exceptions).

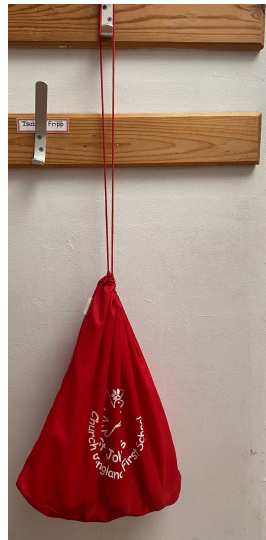


# PE

# Times Tables

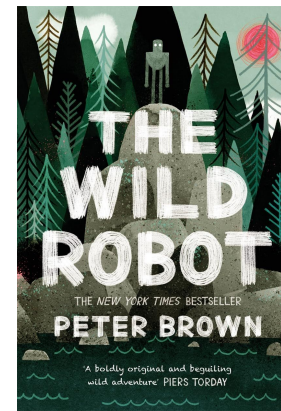
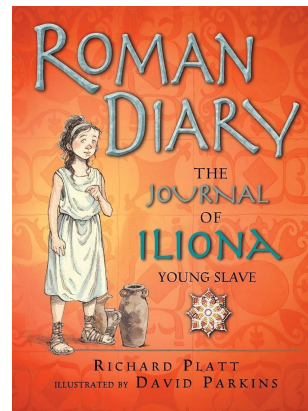
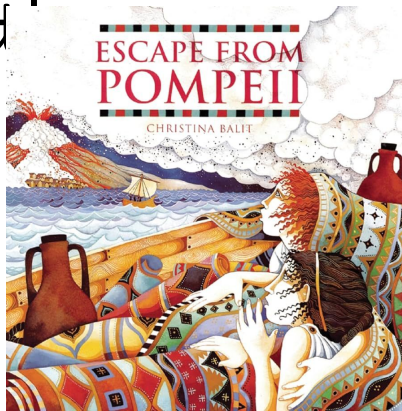


- National Curriculum states that pupils in Year 4 should be able to: *recall multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to  $12 \times 12$*
- Essential for rapid, accurate calculations and problem solving
- Statutory Government Multiplication Tables Check (7-18th June).
- Online test to ensure times table knowledge is at the expected level.
- Little every day - SumDog, apps, games, videos, songs. Books. Please ask for help or suggestions!

# Reading



- Please aim to hear your child read as often as possible.
- Record in Home Link Book
- Children are responsible for changing their own book.
- At St John's our aim is for children to '**read to learn**' and '**read to enjoy**' therefore children will have two books, one to practise essential reading skills and a second book that you can share together.

- Add and subtract numbers with up to **4 digits** , using formal written methods.
- Times table and division facts to **12 x 12**
